1 THIS MATTER having come before the Court on June 18, 2007, on
2 the application of Class Counsel for an award of attorneys' fees and
3 reimbursement of unpaid expenses incurred in this litigation, the Court,
4 having considered all papers filed and proceedings conducted herein, and
5 otherwise being fully informed in the premises and good cause appearing
6 therefore;

7 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that:

8 1. This Court has jurisdiction over the subject matter of this
9 application and all matters relating thereto, including all Members of the
10 Class who have not timely and validly requested exclusion;

11 2. The Court hereby awards attorneys' fees of 25% of the Gross
12 Settlement Proceeds plus expenses, as agreed to and defined in the
13 Stipulation of Settlement with Defendants BAR/BRI and Kaplan, Inc dated
14 February 2, 2007. The current unpaid expenses are in an aggregate amount
15 of \$1,205,205.40. Said fees and expenses shall be allocated among
16 Representative Plaintiffs' Counsel by Lead Counsel in a manner which, in
17 its good-faith judgment, reflects the value of each counsel's contribution to
18 the institution, prosecution and resolution of the litigation. The Court finds
19 the amount of fees awarded and expenses to date is fair and reasonable.
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21 3. The awarded attorneys' fees and expenses shall be paid to
22 Plaintiffs' Counsel from the settlement proceeds, subject to the terms,
23 conditions, and obligations of the Stipulation of Settlement.

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
1 4. Counsel shall be entitled to receive accrued interest attributable
